Finished Size: 53" x 71"

Note: WOF means "width of fabric." Seam allowance is $\frac{1}{4}$ " throughout. If you choose to prewash fabrics, overcast raw edges to avoid loss of fabric through raveling. We use a single fold binding. Tutorial available at fabriccafe.com. If double fold binding is preferred, an additional yard of fabric is needed.

MATERIALS

- * $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd. Dot
- * $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd. Red
- * $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. Green
- * $\frac{2}{3}$ yd. Rainbow Stripe
- * $\frac{2}{3}$ yd. Stripe
- * $\frac{1}{2}$ yd. Circle/Square on Rainbow
- * $\frac{1}{2}$ yd. Flower
- * $\frac{1}{2}$ yd. Blue
- * $\frac{1}{3}$ yd. Circle/Square on White
- * $\frac{1}{3}$ yd. Paisley
- * 5 yds. backing fabric

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From Dot:

- * Cut 2, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "A"**
- * Cut 2, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for **Strip Assembly "B"**
- * Cut 2, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "C"**
- * Cut 4, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF, from these strips, cut 18, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for **Unit "G" Assembly**
- * Cut 2, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF, from these strips, cut 9, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for **Block "C" Assembly**
- * Cut 2, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF, from these strips, cut 9, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for **Block "D" Assembly**

From Red:

- * Cut 2, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "A"**
- * Cut 2, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "B"**
- * Cut 2, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "C"**
- * Cut 3, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Block "A" Assembly**
- * Cut 3, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Block "B" Assembly**
- * Cut 2, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "F"**
- * Cut 3, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Unit "G" Assembly**
- * Cut 7, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border #1

From Green:

- * Cut 4, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "D"**
- * Cut 4, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Block "C" Assembly**
- * Cut 8, $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF for binding



From Rainbow Stripe:

- * Cut 2, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "B"**
- * Cut 2, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "F"**
- * Cut 7, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border #3

From Stripe:

- * Cut 7, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border #2

From Circle/Square on Rainbow:

- * Cut 2, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "A"**

From Flower:

- * Cut 2, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "C"**

From Circle/Square on White:

- * Cut 2, $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "D"**

From Paisley:

- * Cut 2, $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "E"**

From Blue:

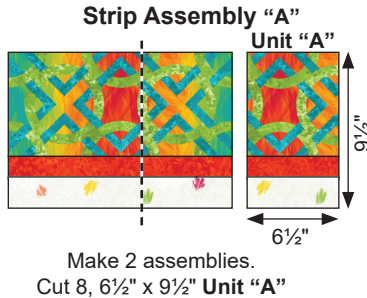
- * Cut 4, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Strip Assembly "E"**
- * Cut 4, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for **Block "D" Assembly**

From Backing Fabric:

- * Cut 2, 90" x WOF

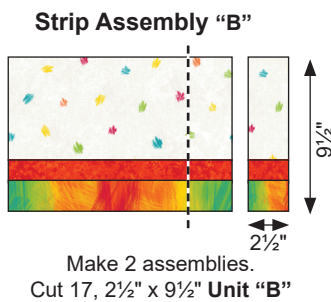
Step 1: Unit “A” Assembly

Referring to **Strip Assembly “A”** diagram, using one circle/square on rainbow, 6½" x WOF strip, one red, 1½" x WOF strip and one dot, 2½" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges as shown. Repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 8, 6½" x 9½" **Unit “A”**.



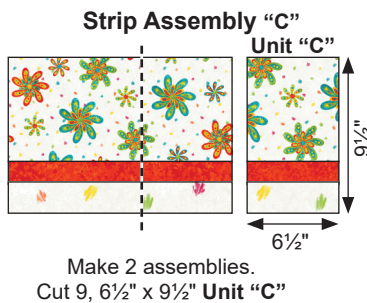
Step 2: Unit “B” Assembly

Referring to **Strip Assembly “B”** diagram, using one dot, 6½" x WOF strip, one red, 1½" x WOF strip and one rainbow stripe, 2½" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges as shown. Repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 17, 2½" x 9½" **Unit “B”**.



Step 3: Unit “C” Assembly

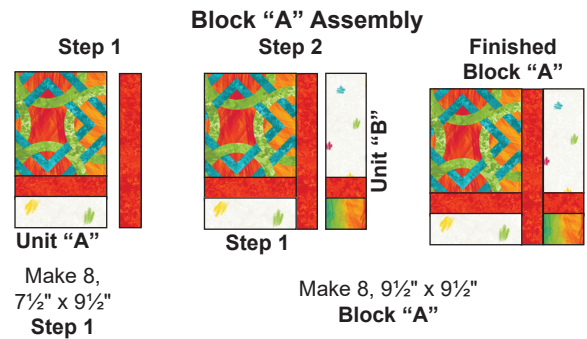
Referring to **Strip Assembly “C”** diagram, using one flower, 6½" x WOF strip, one red, 1½" x WOF strip and one dot, 2½" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges as shown. Repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 9, 6½" x 9½" **Unit “C”**.



Step 4: Block “A” Assembly

Referring to **Block “A” Assembly, Step 1** diagram, using one red, 1½" x WOF strip, sew to side of **Unit “A”** as shown; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat making 8, 7½" x 9½" **Step 1**.

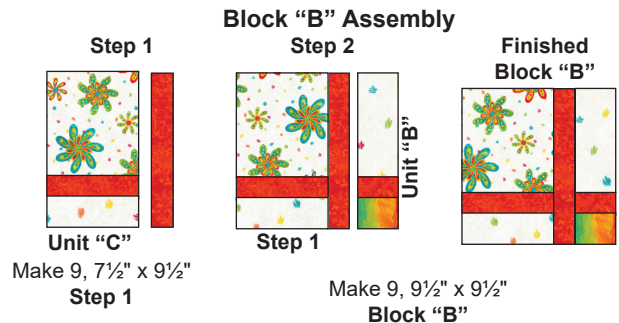
Referring to **Step 2** diagram, using one **Unit “B”**, sew to side of **Step 1** as shown. Repeat making 8, 9½" x 9½" **Block “A”**.



Step 5: Block “B” Assembly

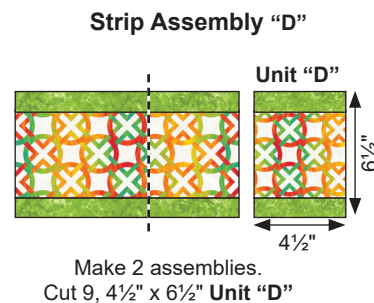
Referring to **Block “B” Assembly, Step 1** diagram, using one red, 1½" x WOF strip, sew to side of **Unit “C”** as shown; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat making 9, 7½" x 9½" **Step 1**.

Referring to **Step 2** diagram, using one **Unit “B”**, sew to side of **Step 1** as shown. Repeat making 9, 9½" x 9½" **Block “B”**.



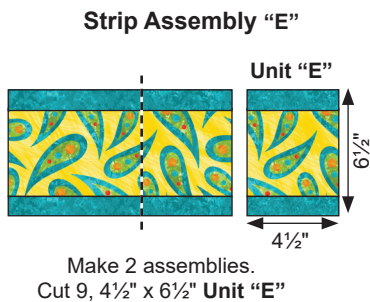
Step 6: Unit “D” Assembly

Referring to **Strip Assembly “D”** diagram, using one circle/square on white, 4½" x WOF strip and 2 green, 1½" x WOF strips, sew together on long edges as shown. Repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 9, 4½" x 6½" **Unit “D”**.



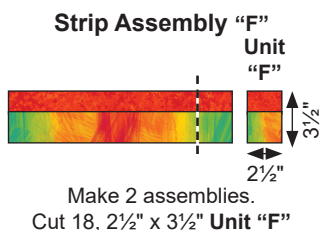
Step 7: Unit “E” Assembly

Referring to **Strip Assembly “E”** diagram, using one paisley, 4½" x WOF strip and 2 blue, 1½" x WOF strips, sew together on long edges as shown. Repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 9, 4½" x 6½" **Unit “E”**.



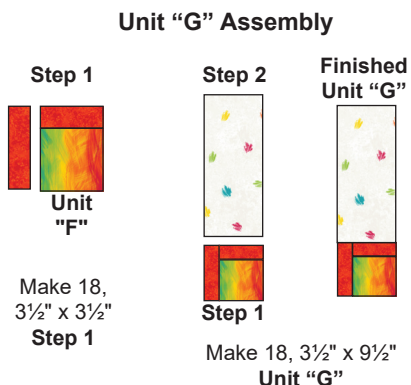
Step 8: Unit “G” Assembly

Referring to **Strip Assembly “F”** diagram, using one rainbow 2½" x WOF strip and one red 1½" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges as shown. Repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 18, 2½" x 3½" **Unit “F”**.



Referring to **Unit “G” Assembly, Step 1** diagram, using one red 1½" x WOF strip, sew to side of **Unit “F”** as shown; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat making 18, 3½" x 3½" **Step 1**.

Referring to **Step 2** diagram, using one dot 3½" x 6½" rectangle, sew to top of **Step 1** as shown. Repeat making 18, 3½" x 9½" **Unit “G”**.



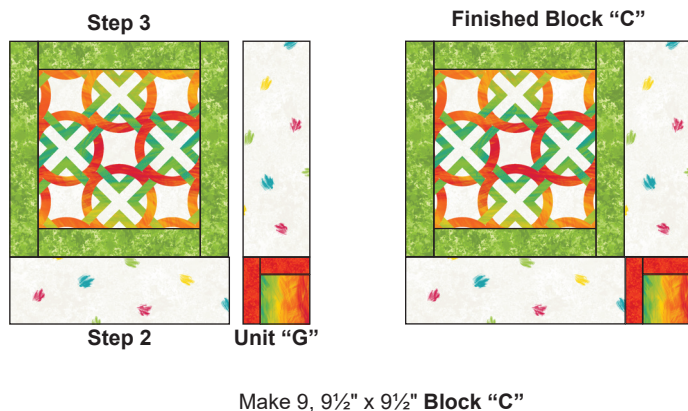
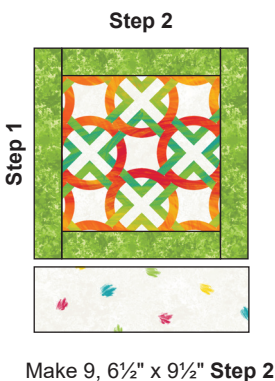
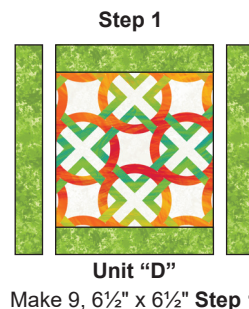
Step 9: Block “C” Assembly

Referring to **Block “C” Assembly, Step 1** diagram, using one green 1½" x WOF strip, sew to side of **Unit “D”** as shown; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat on opposite side. Repeat making 9, 6½" x 6½" **Step 1**.

Referring to **Step 2**, using one dot, 3½" x 6½" rectangle, sew to bottom of **Step 1**. Repeat making 9, 6½" x 9½" **Step 2**.

Referring to **Step 3** diagram, using one **Unit “G”**, sew to side of **Step 2** as shown. Repeat making 9, 9½" x 9½" **Block “C”**.

Step 10: Block “D” Assembly

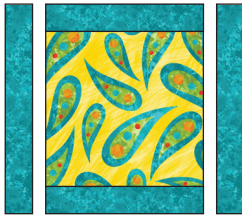
Referring to **Block “D” Assembly, Step 1** diagram, using one blue, 1½" x WOF strip, sew to side of **Unit “E”** as shown; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat on opposite side. Repeat making 9, 6½" x 6½" **Step 1**.

Referring to **Step 2**, using one dot, 3½" x 6½" rectangle, sew to bottom of **Step 1**. Repeat making 9, 6½" x 9½" **Step 2**.

Referring to **Step 3** diagram, using one **Unit “G”**, sew to side of **Step 2** as shown. Repeat making 9, 9½" x 9½" **Block “D”**.

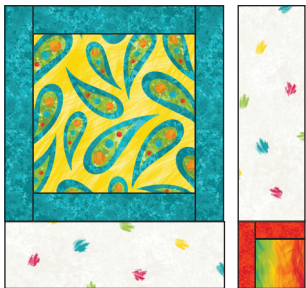

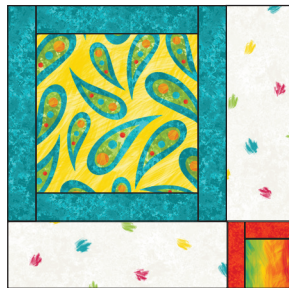

Step 11: Quilt Assembly

Referring to **Row Assembly** diagram, alternating **Blocks “A”, “B”, “C” and “D”** as shown, assemble 7 rows of 5 blocks each. Referring to **Quilt Assembly** diagram, assemble rows.

Step 12: Borders

For border #1, using red, 1½" x WOF border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Using remainder of strip, sew to top and bottom; trim even with sides. For border #2, repeat using stripe, 2½" x WOF border strips. For border #3, repeat using rainbow, 1½" x WOF border strips.

Step 13: Backing & Binding

Sew backing fabric together along trimmed selvage edges; press. Layer top, batting and backing together; quilt as desired. For binding, using green, 1¼" x WOF binding strips, sew strips together end to end. Press in half with wrong sides together; press one raw edge to center fold. Place right side of binding to front side of quilt. Using a scant ¼", sew unpressed edge of binding to quilt, mitering corners. Fold to back and hand stitch in place.
